# View High School Grades, Attendance, Lunch Payments, and Reports Cards on Infinite Campus from Home, Work, or your Phone!

Parents and students have individual access to view grades, attendance, assignments online via the Infinite Campus portal. This link also allows parents to print report cards for insurance purposes (under the Reports tab), deposit money for school lunch and other items (under the Payments tab), and update demographic information.

Download the Infinite Campus app from the App Store and use the district ID# of XBJNVW. Enter your Infinite Campus parent portal username and password to log in. This app allows you to view lunch balances, grades, assignments, and student schedules (under Planner). See all your students in one app!

If you are interested in more details on the College Fair in DesMoines, please click the <u>link</u>. College Fairs are a great way for families to explore college options for future planning with students. Many different institutions will be in attendance to share information, 2 year community colleges and 4 year colleges - local and out-of-state.

An ACT workshop is planned at Pella High School for October 4 & 5. An instructor from the ZAPS company will lead students in a classroom setting with tips and strategies for the ACT standardized test. It is encouraged for juniors to take the ACT test in April or June if they are anticipating attending a four year institution. Visit the Doorway to College website for registration, study tips and stats on the ZAPs workshop benefits. Other ZAPS workshops will be offered in November and March for ACT preparation closer to future testing dates. The ACT registration website has all testing dates and deadlines for the 2017-18 school year.

#### PSAT Testing Info

The Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT®) is cosponsored by the College Board and National Merit Scholarship Corporation. The PSAT/NMSQT is administered to students in grade 11 and grade 10 and is great practice for taking the SAT. It can qualify you for scholarship programs. Also, it can give you insight into which AP® courses you may be ready to take. This year's test will be administered on Wednesday, October 11. Students wishing to take the PSAT/NMSQT must sign up in the Student Services Center in the high school beginning September 11. There are 30 testing spots available this year and priority will be given to students in grade 11. The deadline for signing up is September 29.
