# 2nd Semester Class Schedules, Course Drops or Adds

At the beginning of each semester, students will be allowed five (5) school days in which to add or drop a course. After the tenth (10) school day, dropping a course will result in an "F" for the class, unless an extreme emergency exists.

# Junior Attendance & Decorum

Junior attendance and discipline will be reviewed this spring to determine if open campus privileges will be granted to students when they become seniors. A student must have established positive track records before the school will grant senior release next fall. Parent/Guardian permission must also be given before a student will receive senior release. This release will be available during summer registration.

### Course Registration

Course registration for the 2017-18 school year will be on February 8 through the Infinite Campus student portal. Accurate course registration is very important, as it impacts course offerings and staffing for the next school year. The guidance staff will help students plan their course selections if needed.
