Excellence in Electives is a way for students to highlight the various experiences they gain by taking elective courses here at Pella High. Many high school teachers will be in attendance. Teachers not participating in Excellence in Electives activities will be available in their classrooms for parent-teacher conferences. #### Junior Attendance & Decorum

Junior attendance and discipline will be reviewed this spring to determine if open campus privileges will be granted to students when they become seniors. A student must have established positive track records before the school will grant senior release next fall. Parent/Guardian permission must also be given before a student will receive senior release. This release will be available during summer registration.



#### **Course Registration**

Course registration for the 2015-16 school year will be on February 11 through the Infinite Campus portal. Accurate course registration is very important, as it impacts course offerings and staffing for the next school year. The guidance staff will help students plan their course selections if needed. Changes to schedules may be made at this time if a student needs to add and drop a course.

#### Pella Career Academy - Facility Opening the Start of the 2015-16 School Year

These classes provide our high school students with excellent education opportunities. The students will be able to get a head start on their college and career, explore various career options of interest, develop valuable career and workplace skills, and earn college credit.
