# Cell Phones, Laptops, and Devices No Longer Allowed at Lunch

Becoming an effective communicator and building caring relationships are district brand pillars and goals; unfortunately, students' devices and phones interfere with our ability to successfully do both. After watching "Screenagers" in February, we asked the students to complete a survey about their thoughts on this video and what we could do to support students in our school in regard to screen time. Many students questioned why we allow technological devices at lunch. After much reflection on this, I have asked students to leave all their technology devices in their lockers on a daily basis starting Monday, March 26, the first day of quarter four. Furthermore, I also reminded students not to play violent games on their school issued laptops.

Please know this is not intended to be a punishment. I truly feel a sense of responsibility to help our students accomplish both our district goals, particularly building caring relationships because I know how badly kids yearn to feel known, accepted, and loved. We want to encourage our students to have conversations in person over lunch rather than over their devices. Students may still check their phones during passing periods, but it is our expectation that all phones be kept in their locked lockers for the entirety of the school day.
