

PRIMARY PALETTE

Pella Green and Pella Gray are the official colors for Pella Schools and are shown on the left. It is very important to match these colors faithfully when reproducing the Pella marks. It is greatly preferred that all Pella marks be used in full color whenever possible.

SUPPORT COLORS

In addition to the primary palette, the Pella marks utilize white and black as important support colors.

The Pella marks were designed to create a consistent visual identity for Pella Schools. These marks should not be changed or altered in any way and their use must adhere to the standards in this guide. At the same time, there are many logo variations to choose from so there should be a design compatible to any desired application.

All of the Pella marks are shown in full color on the left.






PELLA MARKS SAFE ZONES

EQUALS ONE SIXTH THE OVERALL HEIGHT OF THE MARK























is intended to maintain the mark's integrity and to avoid visual confusion. No other type or graphic element (including folds, trims or edges) should fall within the safe zone shown. The safe zone for the Pella vertical marks is equal to one sixth the height of the mark (shown on the left at the top). The safe zone for the Pella horizontal marks is equal to one fourth the height of the mark (shown on the left at the bottom). The safe zone spacing is uniform on all sides of the marks.

MINIMUM LOGO SIZES

Each of the Pella marks has a minimum allowable size for printing or other reproduction. To ensure clarity and legibility, the logos must NOT be used any smaller than the sizes shown on this page. It is preferred that, when possible, the logos be used larger than their minimum size.

EMBROIDERY

Contact Pella's administrative offices for information about embroidering spirit marks. Minimum sizes are considerably larger for embroidery.

ARTWORK USE VIOLATIONS



Never use the mark in other colors



Never change the typeface in any part of the mark



Never use unapproved wording in any mark



Never re-size any element in any mark



Never reproportion any mark



Never add any element to any mark



Never distort any mark



Never reposition or realign in any mark



Never re-space any elements in any mark



Never change the outline shape to an unapproved color



Never allow any distracting pattern or photograph to show through any mark




Avoid any background color if it creates insufficient contrast with a mark

So that Pella can maintain the design integrity of its brand, it is mandatory that all marks be applied as indicated in this manual without modification. The marks are not to be altered in any way. Shown on this page are unacceptable uses of the Pella marks.

Exceptions may be made to the guidelines in this manual if approved first by the Pella Administration Office.

RETAIL APPLICATIONS





Each of these shirts would require one color printing to reproduce.

FULL COLOR RETAIL GRAPHICS

In a retail design, if the fabric color matches one of the official colors exactly (Pella Green, Pella Gray, white and sometimes black), the fabric can show through in place of printing that color. If the fabric color does not match any official colors, all official colors (and white) must be used to print the mark.

ALTERNATIVES TO FULL COLOR RETAIL GRAPHICS

When using marks on apparel, the art may print in all green, all black or all white as long the application follows the specifications in this guide. This is a great cost saving alternative to the full color marks.

Note: When selecting fabrics for Pella merchandise please try to stay as close to Pella Green and Pella Gray as possible.
